

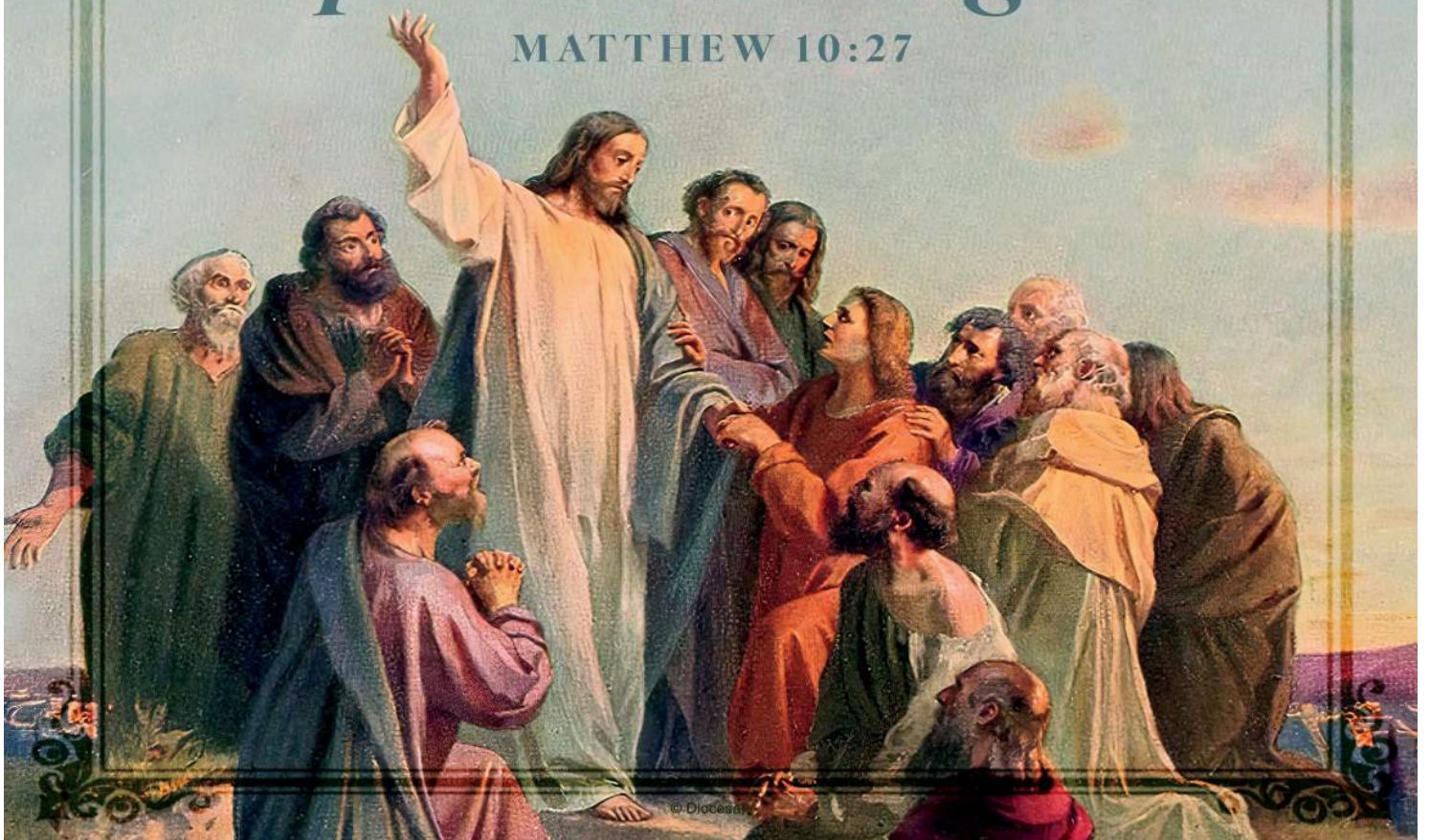

PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear friends,

This week Bishop Lou hosted all the Peoria priests for a convocation in Lake Geneva Wisconsin. Each year the priests typically attend two clergy days in Peoria to have a bit of ongoing formation and receive information from the Diocese and Peoria. Instead of meeting this October, Bishop Lou decided for our 150th diocesan anniversary, to hosts the priests for an extended break outside the diocese to build camaraderie among the priests and have some rest and prayer time together. With all the priests gone, this obviously meant very few masses were said in the diocese this week. Special thanks to Fr Joseph Hogan who offered a daily mass at St Patrick of Merna for those accustomed to Mass each day. Although we tried to communicate well, we had some people show up for our canceled Mass last Sunday at 5:30 pm. I apologize for the inconvenience. Bishop Lou might not call us together again for a week long convocation outside the diocese but it really was a beautiful restful few days with brother priests. Hopefully the people of the Diocese will benefit from the affects of our convocation.

This weekend we celebrate the 12th Sunday of ordinary time. Our readings start with Jeremiah reflecting on betrayal and others plotting against his good. The reality is we have all felt

others not willing our good at times in life. Whether it was real or perceived, the feeling of people waiting for a misstep of ours is an experience we've all had at times. I often think of Jesus at the last supper telling his apostles that all of them will betray him. Of course they respond in shock and doubt but only hours later Peter denies even knowing Jesus. I think we can honestly say that the Apostles probably didn't want to betray Jesus or to turn on Him, but the circumstances of life tempted them to go their own way, protect themselves, and not think of Jesus first. The response of Jeremiah sets the inner disposition each person of faith is called to live. No matter the words or actions of others, we have to focus on doing the good and serving God first. With that mindset, we can still experience challenges in life but we know that our personal relationship with God is of most importance and can pull us up after any difficult situation or conversation.

For this very reason, the reading from Jeremiah is teamed with this reading from the Gospel of Matthew. Again Jesus says not to have fear but that one's lack of fear should flow from a holiness of life. If one believes that there is nothing concealed that will not be revealed, one focuses on pleasing the Lord first with an upright moral life. A healthy fear of judgment encourages our spiritual growth, holiness of life, and authenticity in word and deed. Have a great week.

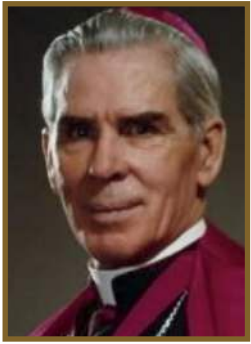

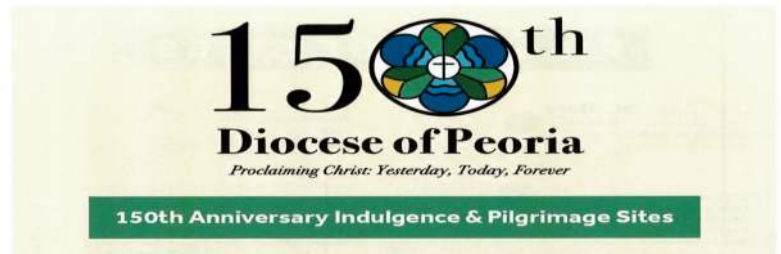
Prayer for Canonization

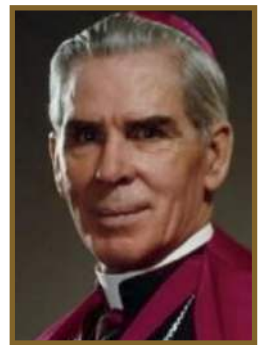

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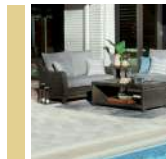
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
